Preliminary Recital Info

Detailed recital info with the specifics of what will be happening the day of the show will be out the end of April. Recital info can also be found posted at the studio and on our website.

- Recital Date: Sunday, June 2nd @ Queens College There will be a morning (1st Show), midday (2nd Show), and evening show (3rd Show). The show that each class will be performing in is listed on the fall schedule under the class time (attached to this email). The highest level classes will be marked to be in multiple shows.
- <u>Picture Days: May 10th and 11th</u> (times t.b.a.). Costumes will be handed out before this date and you will know which day and time your child has pictures closer to the event.
- <u>Dress Rehearsal: Monday, May 20th</u> (times t.b.a.) **@ Queens College**. Attendance is mandatory. Weekday younger students will be earlier in the afternoon and weekend classes will be after 5:30pm, starting with the youngest dancers first. The dancers (comp team excluded) should bring and wear all their costumes for their appropriate dances.
- Being in the recital is a very important aspect of your child's education in the performing arts. It is also a chance for them to show you, their families, and friends all the hard work they've done all year! They will leave the stage with more confidence and an amazing sense of accomplishment! ©

Recital Fee Breakdowns

Costume Fee: *\$75 per student per class. Automatically debited February 15th if you haven't opted out via email before this date. If your dancer takes multiple classes per week, you need to let us know if you do not want costumes for all registered classes. If we hear nothing from you, we will purchase costumes for all their classes. The companies don't refund us, so we cannot refund you. Students will begin being measured the beginning of February.

Recital Fee: \$85.00 per student / \$65.00 for additional siblings (non-refundable fee includes: Trophy, video link of their performance, livestream link during the show, recital t-shirt, professional theater rental, and programs)

You are enrolled to be in the recital when you register for classes. To opt out and not be charged, you need to email the studio before February 15th. Payment plans are available if necessary and requests must be emailed.

*\$75 non-refundable costume fees for each class your child is participating in will be charged on February 15th. This guarantees that we will have the costumes by May for pictures and dress rehearsal. The remaining balance will be due before April 15th. If you have a balance by May 1st, it will be automatically charged with your May tuition. No Refunds. Costumes will not be handed out until all balances are paid. Theater seating is not assigned and is first come first serve. Tickets will start being sold online by mid to late May. Tickets will be \$20 online and \$30 at the door.

Attendance to class is EXTREMELY important now and you are only holding your child back if you allow them to miss class. Illness is always a different story, and we understand that. All make ups should be completed by March 1st. Otherwise, absences occurring after March 1st can also be scheduled and made-up during the last week of classes (June 3rd-9th). Each class will be doing different choreography/dances so your child will not get as much out of doing another class in place of their own. If students miss class, they are going to be behind and hold the rest of the class back. Please keep this in mind! As stated previously in policies and procedures, if a student is more than 15 minutes late to class they will not be allowed to enter. They also need to have and wear the appropriate dress code requirements.
